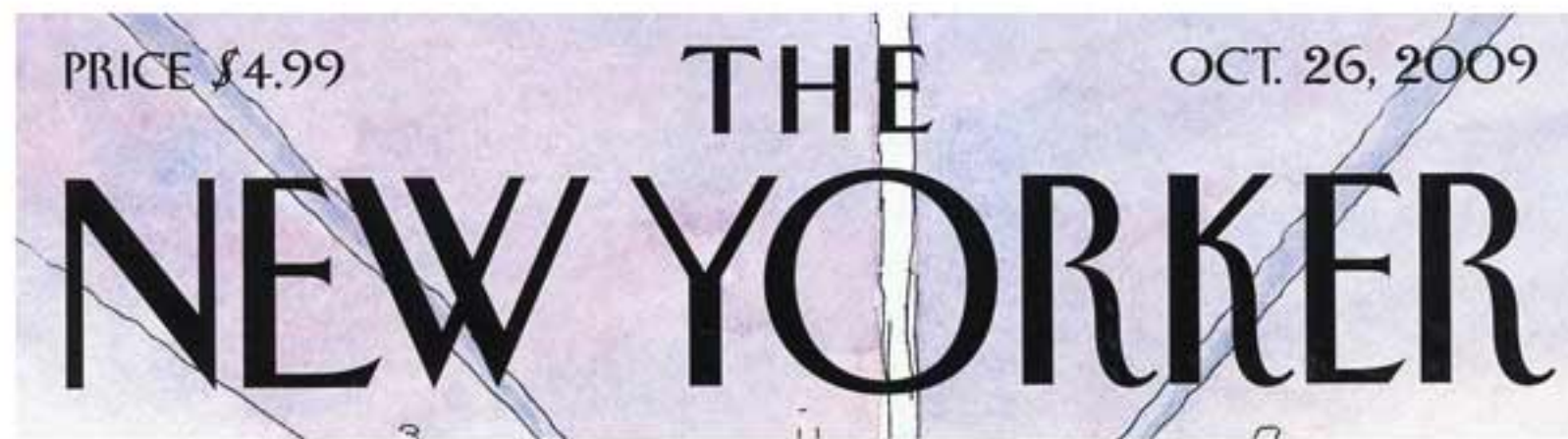

TIM HYDE

There are ambitious concepts behind the photographic projects and video in Hyde's smart, spare show. Not all of them come across, but that doesn't interfere with our appreciation of the works' eccentricity and visual appeal. The most successful series begins with color photographs of a young man in a suburban parking lot struggling with a large white board that he appears to be raising into the air. Hyde has sliced and collaged each of the series' fourteen images to create an architecture of suspended planes, like elements in a kaleidoscope devised by Frank Gehry. As the young artist attempts to balance his shape-shifting ideas, the creative process all but eclipses the material world. Through Oct. 31. (Pro-tetch, 511 W. 22nd St. 212-633-6999.)
